Reading & Language Arts

In ELA students will be assessed on grammar standards from spiral review. We will also assess run ons and fragments. In reading, we will finish the unit on proverbs, adages, and idioms. Then move on to the elements of drama, prose, and poetry.

Math

We will be wrapping up long division this week with word problems, and then with a cumulative assessment. After that, we will be learning about fractions, beginning with fraction equivalence. Equivalent fractions have different denominators and numerators but name the same amount. An example of this is $2/4 = 1/2$.

AC Math

Last week we began a project, Brianna's Backyard. It is the first big project that required extended thinking that we have done. Therefore, lots of guidance has been offered.

Science/Social Studies

In science we've been learning about the states of matter and the water cycle. We will be testing at the end of the week. Students can use their science journals, science textbook, and a quizlet on Mrs. Sattelmeier's blog links to study. Vocabulary to know: solid, liquid, gas, water vapor, condensation, precipitation, evaporation, water cycle, and transpiration. Ask your child to perform the Water Cycle Boogie for you that they learned in science lab.
