Reading & Language Arts

We are revisiting 3rd and 4th grade grammar standards for Language Review. There will be an assessment on Friday. Students will be finalizing their informational essays. Our new reading unit is comparing themes across cultures. Some cultures will include Chinese, Greek, Native American, and African.

Math

We will be learning about mixed numbers and improper fractions this week. Students will decompose fractions and mixed numbers, so that they can convert one to the other. This week there will be daily math spiral review HOMEWORK. It will be reviewed daily in class with students making corrections.

Science/Social Studies

We will be taking our cumulative test covering weather, weather instruments, and clouds on Tuesday, 2/11. To help review for it, check out Mrs. Tansill's blog for a Jeopardy review game as well as reviewing journal entries. Our big cumulating activity will be in the learning commons with Mrs. Nelson this week. Students will write a weather forecast based on weather maps and then film it in front of a green screen.

We will be adding and subtraction fractions this week. This includes having to regroup mixed numbers in order to subtract correctly and convert answers from improper fractions to mixed numbers.

We will have daily math spiral review homework daily. Students will review it in their homeroom class. Another math HW assignment pertaining to the day's lesson may also be assigned.
