### Reading & Language Arts

Most students have completed their informational essay. This week there will be nightly homework focused on grammar standards. This will be in the format of an editing paragraph.

We will complete the unit on comparing themes across cultures. Please read your child's agenda for test date. We will then begin the unit on Greek mythology.

### Math

This week, we will review mixed numbers and improper fractions, before moving on to adding and subtracting fractions.

Students will be taught how to regroup with both operations.

The morning work this week will focus on math. Please review it daily as there will be an assessment over it on Friday.

### Science/Social Studies

This week students will be learning about light. They did several activities involving light in the Science Lab. They will be using the engineering design process to plan, collaborate, and create a light related project. We don't want to give too much away but be sure to ask your child to share the details with you Thursday. Students will need to know these terms: light, transparent, translucent, opaque, reflect, refract, prisms, angles, mirror, and source.
