## Reading & Language Arts

We will continue to identify and develop prepositional phrases for at least another week. The students have been taught to identify the object of the preposition. Students are reading texts and short passages to identify the structure as : description, cause & effect, problem & solution, order & sequence, or compare & contrast.

## Math

We will continue to practice multiplication strategies, including the Area Model (Box Method), and the "Bow-Tie" method. Both teach students to use the distributive law to multiply. We will apply these strategies to solve word problems.

## Science/Social Studies

Students will be presenting their Sway or Power Point projects on an assigned person from the American Revolution. We will then be studying some of the different battles of the Revolution. Please encourage your child to bring home their Social Studies journal nightly to study.

## AC Reading & Language Arts

AC ELA will be continuing our study of text structure (description, compare/contrast, problem/solution, cause and effect, and sequence (chronological order and "how to" steps.)

Students also will be writing dialog between two characters from two different books, *Sign of the Beaver* and *Brother Eagle, Sister Sky*.

In grammar we will continue our study of prepositional phrases.

## AC Math

We will continue to work on the different forms of multiplication. We have focused on 2/3 digit x 1 digit and will be moving towards 2 digit x 2 digit. Once again, we will be using the area model (box method), partial products (bow tie), and "old school." We might even get into learning about factors and multiples by the end of the week.
