Reading & Language Arts

Students are comparing first and secondhand accounts on the same topic. They are supporting their reasoning on graphic organizers to help focus on key elements.

In writing, they continue to develop an opinion essay. This includes a clear opinion statement, 3 reasons, examples, and a conclusion.

AC Reading & Language Arts

AC ELA will complete and publish text structure magazines, take a comprehension assessment, and begin work on types of sentences.

Math

This week, students continue their study of factors and multiples. They need to be able to find factor pairs for a given number. Familiarity with the divisibility rules for 2, 3, 6, 5, and 10 will be helpful to them in doing this. They also need to identify a number as prime or composite, based on the number of factor pairs the number has.

AC Math

We began factors, multiples, and divisibility rules at the end of the week last week. This week we will continue to practice them and assess on Friday.

Science/Social Studies

We are going to be studying the movement of energy through ecosystems for a few weeks. In this unit, students will use models to show their understanding of the roles of organisms within an ecosystem, the flow of energy within an ecosystem, and changes to an ecosystem caused by living and non-living factors. Students will need to be familiar with this vocabulary: organisms, energy, ecosystem, producers, consumers, decomposers, food web, food chain, flow, scarce, extinct, and over-abundant.
