Reading & Language Arts

Students will be identifying and editing run on sentences and fragments. This carries over to their opinion essay development. They have been researching for facts to support their opinion stance.

Our figurative language unit will be focused on similes and metaphors.

Math.

We will review and practice concepts relating to factors, multiples, and prime & composite numbers. There will be a cumulative assessment on this unit, after which we will move on to long division in class. In morning work we will be looking at both number and shape patterns.

Science/Social Studies

Our students enjoyed participating in our fieldtrip to the Cobb Youth Museum. Some of them took their parts very seriously! It was a great capstone to our study of the Revolutionary War. This week students will be going to the Learning Commons where they will be working in groups to apply the engineering design process. They will be planning, designing, and creating models of food webs in ecosystems. Ask your student at the end of the week to explain how energy moves through their food web.
