About Addison's 4th Grade

Week of September 30 – October 4, 2019

Reading & Language Arts

Students are finalizing their narrative essays. We continue to work on correct punctuation for dialogue.
Character traits is our reading focus.

Math

This week we will continue to work on solving multi-step problems with addition and subtraction. We will revisit rounding so that we can estimate sums and differences. After we have reviewed concepts of addition and subtraction, students will have their summative assessment on this unit.

Science/Social Studies

We will be putting up a white flag on the Revolutionary War for a few weeks and returning to science. We will be learning about the solar system, beginning with comparing the sun and stars. Students will learn what a star is, how stars are alike and different, how the sun compares with other stars, and how we know what is in the night sky.

As a reminder, all 4th grade teachers are requiring that students identify key details in social studies and science texts. Just because you learned a strategy in ELA doesn't mean you can't apply it in other subjects as well. ☺
